Tapestry

New parents will shortly be receiving an email to complete their registration for their Tapestry account. We would love for you to add any WOW moments or special events in your child's life on the Tapestry Learning Journey. They don't need to be amazing feats, just special to your child. Each week you will either receive a photo and a short sentence or a longer focus observation, we aim to alternate these through the year. As I am sure you can imagine, writing up the observations take staff a long time and requires time away from the children. Therefore, we have decided to reduce the amount of longer observation write ups and focus on spending time with the children teaching, scaffolding and moving them on in the learning.

Invoices

Invoices have been emailed via Parentadmin.com. Our invoices look slightly different this year for children receiving the 3 and 4 year old funding, as we have separated the funded hours from the consumable rate. Another reminder, that 2 year old funding is for 15 free hours with no consumables and the 3 and 4 year old funding has a consumable charge per session. Our Fees are attached again for reference. If you have not received the right funded hours applied to your invoice, this may be because you haven't returned your Funding Declaration Form which was due back by Friday 30th August. I have attached again for those parents who receive funding, this is all 3 and 4 year olds, (unless you are using your funding at another childcare setting) and those 2 year olds who have the Working Parents Entitlement.

Invoices are to be paid by Friday 13th September.

Session Times

Children staying for the later sessions 1.30pm and 2.30pm will need to bring in a healthy packed lunch in an appropriate lunch box/bag (no plastic bags), we ask that you do not include fizzy drinks, sweets or chocolate. We do encourage the children to eat everything you provide, but please be realistic with the amount your child can eat. We do ask that nobody brings in any nuts/peanut butter due to nut allergies. Please ensure grapes/olives/cherry tomatoes are cut up to avoid a choking hazard.

IMPORTANT: Please ensure the child's name is clearly visible on the outside of the lunchbox/bag.

We love celebrating your children's Birthdays at preschool with a special recognition at carpet time and all the children singing Happy Birthday. **Do not bring in any gifts, cake or treats** to hand out to the children.
