Our theme this week has been about travel and holidays, as we've explored learning through cars, aeroplanes, boats and trains. With shells, the children printed patterns into playdough and made prints with paint. The children loved using the spray bottles with watery paint to make patterns on a big screen. Some of our children can write recognisable letters, but lots are exploring making marks and learning that marks have a meaning. Therefore, writing postcards is great for children to understand there's a purpose for writing.
